LEADERSHIP BROWARD is a premier leadership development program, designed for adults who currently hold leadership positions and are involved in their community. The 10-month program exposes participants to a multitude of issues and resources related to our community.



YOUTH LEADERSHIP BROWARD

YLB is a nine-month program that provides an opportunity for students to gain real-life experiences through interactions with community leaders from businesses, government agencies, and civic organizations; develop essential leadership skills such as team building, conflict resolution, time management, public speaking and goal setting; and impact the community through an ongoing service project throughout the year.



WOMEN LEADING BROWARD

WLB's purpose is to provide opportunities for high potential women to develop their skills and advance their careers through mentoring, education, and networking, inspiring them to serve as leaders. WLB is designed to provide women with the opportunity to achieve the following goals:

2018-2019 Revenue

Leadership Broward Foundation had an excellent year! Our revenue continues to be balanced with over 36% of LB's revenue coming from our core programs, Leadership Broward, Youth Leadership Broward, and Women Leading Broward. Our events make up a significant amount of revenue, with 26% from Profiles in Leadership, 18% Turkey Trot, 9% Fun Lunch, and 2% Men of Style. Grants made up 2% of the revenue while Membership and Alumni Activities ended at 7%. All in all a great year for Leadership Broward.
